## BUILDING CLOSURES

### Facilities Schedule: Winter Recess & J-Term

*In keeping with the University's commitment to limit our carbon footprint, please be advised of the following facilities schedules for the winter recess and J-term:*

#### Winter Recess:

All SPS facilities will remain closed during the winter recess: Thursday, December 23, 2021 through Monday January 3, 2022.

#### J-Term Limited Access:

The SPS facility at 7 East 12 Street will remain open Tuesday, January 4 through Thursday, January 6 and Monday, January 10 through Thursday, January 13, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. It will remain closed Friday through Sunday until Martin Luther King Jr. Weekend.
