

## Application Checklist & Instructions

### General Application Requirements (required of all applicants):

- Online Application: [apply.sps.nyu.edu/grad](https://apply.sps.nyu.edu/grad)
- Application Fee
  - \$150, non-refundable
  - Payment of the fee is not an indication of submission. The application must be submitted after the application fee has been paid.
- Transcripts
  - Academic transcripts are required from all colleges and universities attended.
- Résumé
  - There is no page limit to resume length.
  - Include as much detail as possible about past or present experience.
- 1 Letter of Recommendation
  - Recommendations should be submitted from a professional email address.
  - Recommenders may include past or present faculty, employers or colleagues, but not personal acquaintances.
  - Ensure your recommenders are aware of the application deadline.
- Video & Writing Reflection
  - 10 - 15 minutes to complete
  - Consists of a recorded video question and a 10 minute timed writing essay
  - To complete this requirement, you will need a desktop or laptop computer with a functioning webcam, microphone, and internet connection.

### International Applicants - Additional Requirements:

- Evaluation of International Transcripts
  - Each international transcript must be evaluated for equivalency to the US educational system for admission and transfer credit purposes.
  - Evaluations are acceptable only from the following NACES accredited organizations:
    - o Educational Credential Evaluators, Inc. (ECE)
    - o Educational Perspectives, nfp
    - o Foreign Academic Credential Service, Inc.
    - o Transcript Research
    - o Span Tran
    - o World Education (WES)
- TOEFL/IELTS
  - All international applicants who did not complete an undergraduate or graduate degree in the US or in a program where the medium of instruction is English are required to submit TOEFL or IELTS.
